Following the Tory Government announcement on public sector pay rises - Nurses, Healthcare Assistants, Domestics, Porters, Support Staff and other Health Professionals will **NOT** get a pay rise. We are calling on local politicians to put pressure on the Government to give health workers the recognition they deserve.

Without the phenomenal efforts of all NHS staff within the Pennine Acute Hospitals NHS Trust during this pandemic there is no doubt the death rates would have been higher. NHS staff have continued to work and have put their own health on the line to care for and treat the sick and the vulnerable. The staff have been there when patients' own families couldn't be.
